Frontier Revolver Match Rules and Procedures

- 1. Match Rules: As of April 28, 2011
 - a. There are two categories, <u>Cartridge Revolver</u> and <u>Cap and Ball Revolver</u> (participants may enter both categories)
 - b. All firing is done one handed "duelist style".
 - c. Revolvers must have fixed sights and be from the frontier era.
 - d. Cartridge revolvers may use black powder or smokeless cartridges.
 - e. Western/frontier/ Civil War attire is strongly encouraged.
 - f. Put name and category on all targets.
 - g. Turn in completed targets to the scoring table. Results are announced at the end of the match
- 2. Course of Fire: Total for regular match and special target is 36 rounds
 - a. Regular Match (Cartridge and Cap and Ball Categories). 30 rounds, total as follows:

i.	12 rounds at "Bull's-eye" target	10 paces
ii.	6 rounds at "Candle" target	10 paces
iii.	6 rounds at "Ace of Spades" target	5 Paces
iv.	6 rounds at "metal" targets	10 paces

b. Special Event Target (optional) 6 rounds at the 10 Paces

3. Rewards:

- a. Medals for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} place in each category.
- b. Participation medals are available for an extra \$15.00. Place your order at the scoring table. These are a great keepsake!
- c. Special Event Targets, For an Extra \$5.00 shoot at the Special Target. Winner will receive a special medallion!

4. Registration from 8:00AM to 8:45 AM.

- a. Match commences at 9:00 AM and usually completes around High Noon to 1:00PM
- b. Cost is \$15.00 per match category; this includes a one year membership in the "Friends of the James Farm". (e.g. one category and a special event target costs \$20.00)
